

- Scholarships will be awarded on merit. Prior to submission of an application, applicants should ensure they meet the selection criteria appropriate to the scholarship sought.
- Shortlisted applicants for Academic and Co-curricular scholarships will undergo an interview process
- Shortlisted applicants for Music scholarships will be invited to audition
- Invitation to attend an interview or music audition will not necessarily mean a scholarship will be offered.
- Results of scholarship selection are confidential and will not be released by the College.
- Following the interview process, offers will be made in writing by the Principal.
- For students who are not currently attending the College, acceptance of an offer will require payment of application and entrance fees as listed on the ELTHAM College Application Form.
- Acceptance and payment of these fees will be required by the due date or the offer will be withdrawn.
- Scholarships will be awarded on the understanding that the student will maintain high standards of academic achievement, participate to the best of their ability in school activities and adhere to the school policies and rules.
- Scholarships will be reviewed annually and may be withdrawn if expectations are not met.

Additional Terms and Conditions for General Excellence (Music) Scholarship

- Music scholarship recipients are expected to participate in a minimum of two music ensembles (i.e. instrumental ensembles or choirs) as specified by the Director of Music.
- Music scholarship recipients are expected to participate in any music performances that are relevant to their year level and instrument, such as music concerts and musical theatre productions.
- The General Excellence (Music) Scholarship is intended for the instrument on which the student performed during their audition. If the student discontinues lessons on that instrument the scholarship may be withdrawn, even if they have commenced playing another instrument.
